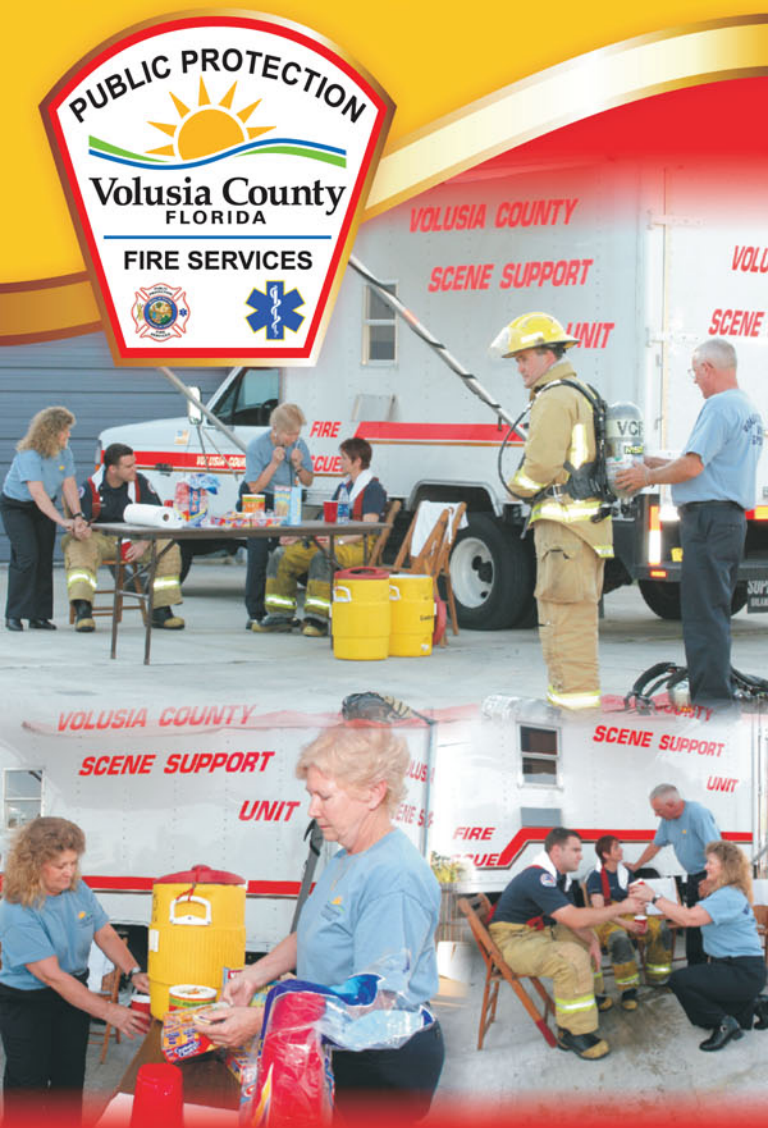

Members provide support to personnel who often work under hot and dangerous conditions. They provide food and drink to the firefighters, refill their airpacks and monitor their vital signs so they can continue to work safely. Rehab members receive training in CPR and emergency vehicle operations and meet weekly to keep their skills current.
