

## **MOSQUITO CONTROL SUPERVISOR**

### MAJOR FUNCTION

Supervisory work in directing the activities of Mosquito Control Inspectors in inspecting, larviciding and adult mosquito control.

### ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

(NOTE: These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Supervises and coordinates Mosquito Control Inspectors in field inspection of suspected mosquito breeding areas, taking adult mosquito count surveys, investigating public mosquito complaints, educating the public to mosquito control methods, mosquito larviciding operations with ground equipment.

Coordinates making systematic inspections of mosquito producing areas for mosquito immatures and water conditions that may produce mosquitoes.

Assigns and supervises ULV machine operations and schedules adulticiding operations using information received by the telephone from the public, adult mosquito counts, and by investigating public mosquito complaints.

Works with source reduction personnel in suggesting ditch maintenance work for dragline, bulldozers, large tractor mower and maintenance crews where such maintenance affects mosquito production.

Performs and supervises building and equipment maintenance tasks as required.

Trains personnel assigned to mosquito larviciding operations in the proper use of equipment, recognition of mosquito larvae, and possible breeding areas.

Supervises additional part time personnel assigned to larviciding operations during the mosquito breeding season.

Prepares logs, records, maps, and reports on the control of mosquitoes.

## **(Mosquito Control Supervisor continued)**

Serves as key person in dealing with telephone service requests.

Performs related work as required.

### KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Knowledge of the mosquito breeding habits and spraying techniques used to control immature and adult mosquitoes. Knowledge of the supervisory techniques of supervising skilled and semi-skilled personnel.

Ability to plan and assign work of ground crews. Ability to carry out assignments with only general supervision. Ability to communicate effectively with the public and fellow workers. Ability to coordinate tasks with other divisions and agencies.

Skilled in small boat operation in performing tasks assigned by director.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, and three (3) years of experience as a Mosquito Control Inspector supplemented by supervisory experience or equivalent experience identifying mosquito larvae in the field and participating in a larviciding program.

Possession of a valid Florida driver's license. Must be examined and certified in Public Health Pest Control within six (6) months of appointment.

A comparable amount of education, training, or experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

### ADA REQUIREMENTS

**Physical Demands:** Medium work to heavy work. Ability to traverse uneven, wet, broken terrain. Ability to see, talk, hear; reach, walk, bend, squat, kneel, grasp.

**Environmental Demands:** Outside work. Ability to tolerate inclement weather including rain, humidity, heat, cold, and lightning. Exposure to saltwater, chemicals, insects, toxic plants, snakes, salt air.

**Mental Demands:** Ability to read and comprehend technical and scientific reports and manuals; instructions, procedures, memos, letters. Ability to perform shop math. Ability to speak clearly and concisely to public and laymen; conversant in theory and practices of discipline. Ability to write reports, instructions, procedures, memos, letters, etc.
