### MAJOR FUNCTION

Skilled professional work surgically sterilizing dogs and cats; and overseeing all medical examination and treatment of animals on the Mobile Spay/Neuter clinic.

### ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

(NOTE: These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Performs spay/neuter surgeries for dogs and cats on the mobile surgical clinic for owned dogs and cats. Oversees pre- and post- operative care of animals brought to mobile clinic for spay/neuter. Examines animals brought to mobile surgical clinic for spay/neuter.

Administers rabies vaccinations on the mobile clinic at off-site locations.

Oversees the maintenance of surgical equipment and area.

Provides veterinarian services during emergency/disaster situations.

Supervises veterinarian assistants in animal care; ordering equipment and supplies; and maintenance and cleaning of the mobile spay/neuter clinic.

Performs related work as required.

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of proper care and handling dogs and cats under stressful situations. Knowledge of veterinarian medical terms and medications. Thorough knowledge of Volusia County codes and ordinances related to Animal Control issues. Knowledge of animal types, species, and breed identification. Knowledge of humane animal care, capture, and restraint.

Ability to handle dogs and cats. Ability to perform surgery on dogs and cats. Ability to administer medication as directed. Ability to keep records and utilize a computer. Ability to communicate effectively with the public. Ability to make sound decisions in a stressful situation.

### MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a doctoral degree of Veterinarian Medicine and two years experience administering to dogs and cats.

Possession of a valid Florida Drivers License

ADA REQUIREMENTS

Physical Demands: Medium work lifting up to 50 lbs and/or carrying objects weighting up to 25 lbs. Stooping, kneeling, reaching. Finger dexterity, vision.

Mental Demands: Practical application of fractions, percentages, ratio and proportion. Read and understand safety rules, methods and procedures.

Environmental Demands: Mainly inside work.
